How can I afford a private education for my child?

Any student enrolled in Chaparral Christian Community School qualifies for state Empowerment Scholarship Funds (ESA). Please visit www.azed.gov/esa for information and to apply.

Apply for ESA funds as soon as possible. If you miss a quarter you will be able to apply anytime throughout the year.

OR

For AZ Tax Credit Scholarships we use ACSTO as our tax credit organization. To apply for tax credit scholarship on online, go to http://acsto.org/parents/apply-now

Again apply as soon as possible but know you will be able to apply anytime throughout the entire school year.

More Info- *Please read carefully*:

- 1. Apply at more tax credit organizations. We have had luck with IBE to receive further scholarships. You can apply on their website (https://www.ibescholarships.org/). You can see the entire list of certified tax credit organizations at https://azdor.gov/sites/default/files/REPORTS_sto-i-list.pdf and can apply to as many as you want. Kindergarten students and new students qualify for the Overflow /Plus money that you may see on applications.
- 2. Ask friends and family to donate their tax credit money to ACSTO specifically in your child's name and all that money will specifically go to your child. They can still donate for the 2022 tax year until April 15 (some of you have done this already and <u>yes</u> you will automatically get whatever was donated specifically to your child.) **You cannot donate to your own child.**
- 3. Your child must be considered a K-12 student to receive a tax credit scholarship. Tax credit scholarships are not available for preschool students unless they are on an IEP. That's a state law.
